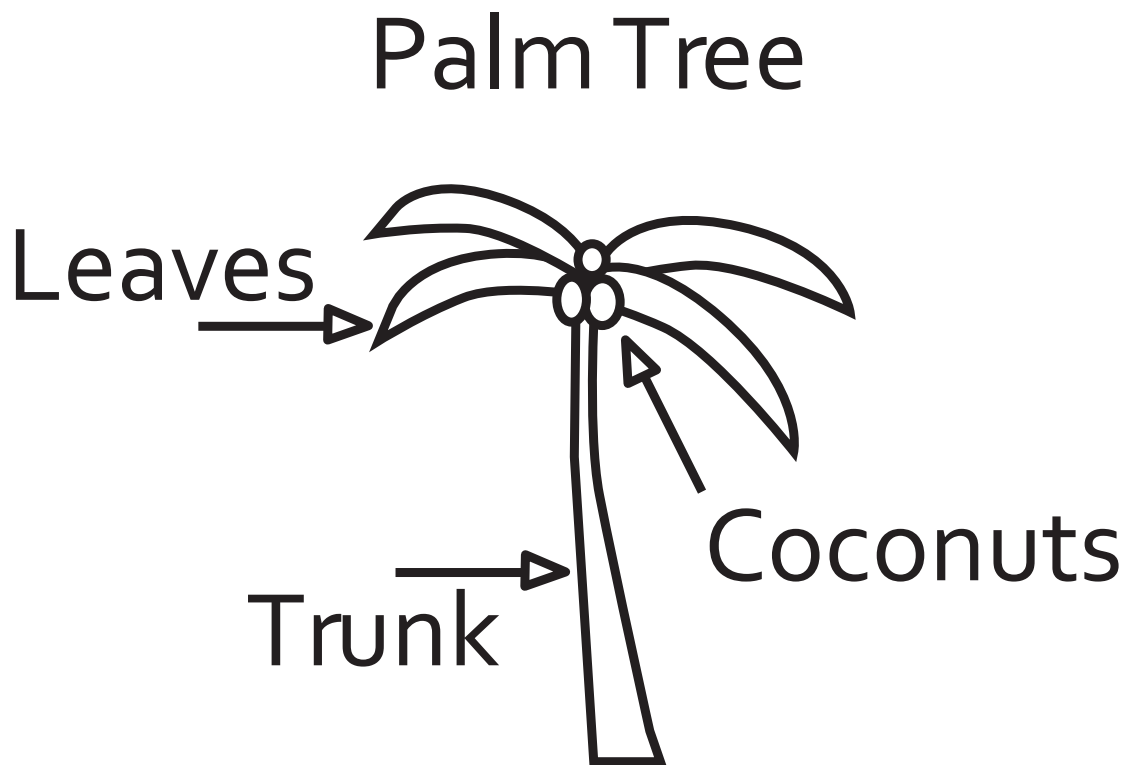

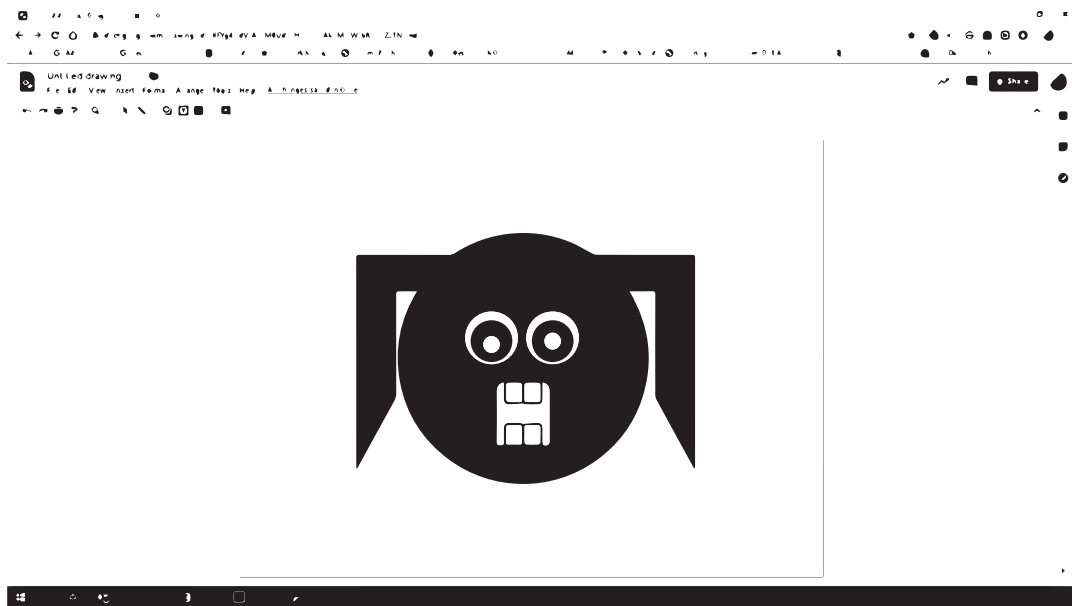

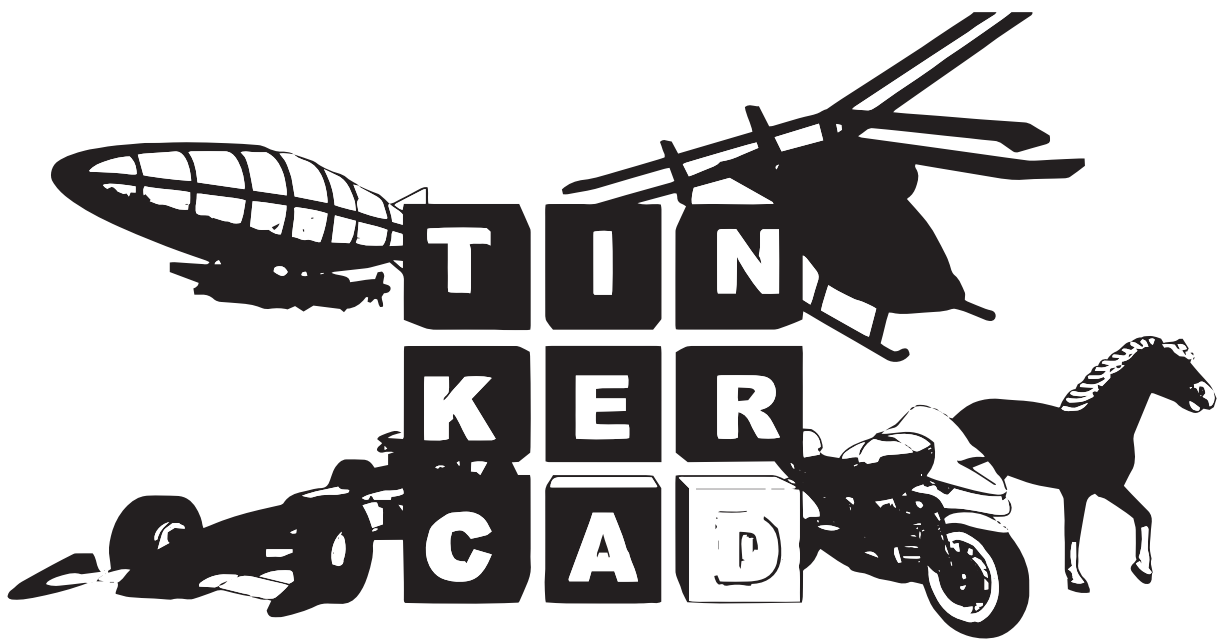

Online Images

Finding images online

Google Images is one of many search services that allow users to search the World Wide Web for image content. It requires the searcher to think about the key words that best describe the image they are looking for. The searcher can also use different filters to search for more specific images. Two important things to remember: are copyright of an image and resolution size. Some online image search tools are listed below:

Creating digital images

Microsoft Paint is a simple graphics editor that has been included with all versions of Microsoft Windows. The program opens and saves files in Windows bitmap, JPEG, GIF, PNG, and single-page TIFF formats. This application allows the user to change the file type of an image, which is useful if the application you are using does not accept a particular file type.

Open Source images

Using open Source images

Find the correct image that is free for you to use. Always provide evidence of the rights when using an image.

Open source images are either images free from copyright or under Creative Commons. Images free from copyright can be used for anything without any limitations. Creative Commons (CC) is a non-profit organisation that provides free licences for creators to use when making their work available to the public. These licences help the creator to give permission for others to use the work in advance under certain conditions.
