Monologue

Present a monologue

The word monologue comes from the Greek word monos, which means "alone," and logos, which means "speech." It is a speech or verbal presentation given by a single character in order to express his or her collection of thoughts and ideas aloud.

A monologue has a similar structure to a speech. It has an introduction, content and conclusion, although monologues generally uses more emotional and facial expressions, (it can be like telling a story).
