

Quadrant 1 are closed textual questions.
Here, **there is an answer to the question**, and through applying comprehension skills to the text, it can be discovered.

TEXTUAL QUESTIONS

Quadrant 2 are open textual questions.
Here students must **speculate, or draw inferences from the text provided to answer the questions** in a way they feel is justified.

You can use your imagination to answer these questions

Answer can be found in a book

CLOSED QUESTIONS

QUESTION QUADRANT

OPEN QUESTIONS

Ask an expert questions. Answers can be found in books, websites, etc

Quadrant 3 are closed intellectual questions.
These questions are based on factual knowledge that can be sought from an expert or other information source.

INTELLECTUAL QUESTIONS

Need to discuss questions. Questions that may have more than one possible answer

Quadrant 4 are what Cam calls inquiry questions – these are mostly what we might describe as big or fertile questions for inquiry.
