What is a question? This is hard to answer, but
the function of a question is easier. **The
function of a question is to
seek information.**

A **closed question** can be
answered with either a single word or
a short Phrase. A closed question can
be answered with either 'yes' or 'no'.

An **open question** is likely to receive a long more
in depth answer.
Open questions have the following characteristics:
They ask the questioned to think and reflect.
They will give you opinions and feelings.
They hand control of the conversation to the questioned .
